

Scholarship Application

Frank W. Moore Scholarship

The Indiana Funeral Directors Association awards this scholarship in memory of Frank W. Moore to recognize the understanding of, and dedication to, the philosophy and standards of funeral service to a deserving mortuary science student. The scholarship is in the amount of \$ 1000.

Selection Criteria:

The applicant must (1) be an Indiana resident attending an accredited funeral service education program; (2) be enrolled in the final year of the program; (3) submit a letter of recommendation from a practicing funeral director (other than a family member) or from a faculty member at the college; (4) submit the short essay answers to the questions listed below; and (5) complete and submit the Scholarship Application form along with a transcript of their funeral service education program grades.

Essays: Please answer the following short essay questions. (Must be typewritten.)

1. Why have you chosen funeral service as your profession?
2. What do you hope to achieve and contribute to funeral service?
3. What do you foresee as the future of funeral service?
4. What role does the funeral director play in their community?

All requested materials must accompany application.

Winner of the scholarship will be announced at the IFDA Annual Convention and will then be notified by mail.
Payment of the scholarship will be made to the school following award of scholarship.
